WHAT IS ILLUMINATE?

Illuminate is a Female Entrepreneurial Business Management and Leadership Programme. The original concept was developed by The MBI Enterprise Hub and DKT who identified a need to support existing female entrepreneurs in the North East Region and DCU Ryan Academy were invited to deliver the programme.

It is kindly sponsored by Coca-Cola International Services, AIB, M1 Drogheda Chamber Skillnet, and the Meath and Louth Local Enterprise Offices.

Only 20 participants will be selected for this programme which will fast track female led businesses, to develop their business and leadership skills, achieve scale and create employment. Participants will be given the knowledge, skills and understanding to commercialise sustainable and profitable products and services, that customers need

The Illumination of the Newgrange solstice was first seen over 5000 years ago. The definition of Illumination is "to make lucid or clear or to throw light on a subject" This course continues a tradition of creativity and innovation, as participants will be guided by Ireland's most experienced tutors, and will develop a Business Case Model that will act as a practical guide to direct their business.

A selection of expert trainers will deliver this programme. At the end of the course participants will be required to submit a completed <u>Business Model Canvas</u> and on the Final Day each participant will present an Investor Pitch to a Panel of Experts.

Certificates of completion will be presented on this day, and all participants will automatically become part of the DCU Ryan Academy Female Entrepreneurship network which will enable them to attend all networking events organized by the DCU Ryan Academy.
