# The "Secrets to Success" revealed at the Cavan Business Women's Club

Over 80 business women and some business men heard some secrets to business success from two leading entrepreneurs, **Sean Gallagher**, well-known entrepreneur, speaker and business writer and **Alison Ritchie**, Managing Director of Polar Ice, a Portarlington, based company that supplies dry ice to many special effect companies - including those involved in making Game of Thrones.

The event was held in the Hotel Kilmore on Wednesday April 25th. Both spoke about their business journey and shared some learning's on how to be successful.

In his presentation Sean Gallagher applauded the SME sector for their contribution to the economy and made reference to the Cavan / Monaghan area as being particularly strong for self employment / SME sector. He also stressed the usefulness of being involved in a network to grow a business. Alison Ritchie spoke of her steep learning curve when she took over the running of Polar Ice Ltd from her father and shared how she overcame the many obstacles faced in growing the company to where it is today, employing 17 staff and an annual turnover of over €2m.
