A word from Marcella Redden, Head of Enterprise, LEO Cavan

In 2013 Local Enterprise Office Cavan felt it was appropriate to establish a formal business network to encourage and promote female entrepreneurship. In May of that year, we launched Cavan Business Women's Club (CBWC), a professional business women's network at an event in the Farnham Estate Cavan.

With an objective to facilitate female entrepreneurs and potential entrepreneurs, promoting an entrepreneurial mind-set and encouraging women to choose self-employment as a career choice, the network has proved very successful over the past seven years.

Through the CBWC we have engaged with some 500 women in business spanning 26 different business sectors and raised the profile of female led businesses in the county. The group has heard from many successful and inspirational business women who have empowered the members to develop and grow their own businesses.

In 2020, like all other networks and businesses, Cavan Business Women's Club had to change the approach to networking events and after the launch event in February, went online for meetings.

Unfortunately, we will have to take the same approach for meetings in 2021 while the restrictions around COVID19 remain and so that we all #StaySafe.

I am delighted to say that Local Enterprise Cavan is very happy to continue to support this progressive business women's network in 2021 and I confirm that Margaret McKeon-Boyle will continue to act Coordinator of Cavan Business Women's Club.
