# 106 Cavan female entrepreneurs join nationwide celebrations for 'National Women's Enterprise Day'

## One of the largest NWED events in Ireland

'From Local to Global' was the theme for this year's National Women's Enterprise Day (NWED) that was celebrated by 106 local female entrepreneurs at an event in the Hotel Kilmore on Thursday October 18th. Hosted by the Local Enterprise Office Cavan and the Cavan Business Women's Club, those in attendance heard from Minister Heather Humphreys T.D. (Minister for Business, Enterprise and Innovation) who launched the event; Cathaoirleach Cllr. Madeleine Argue also spoke and said that the success of Cavan Business Women's Club demonstrates the need and desire amongst us to network and be part of a local support system that encourages female entrepreneurship. Mary McKenna, Tour America and finalist in this year EY Entrepreneur of the Year in the international category, talked about how she grew her business to have a €21 million turnover and described the many challenges she had to overcome along the way, and local Stradone business woman Ann Rudden of Aine Handmade Chocolates spoke of how she grew her business to go from local to global.

Heather Humphreys T.D., Minister for Business, Enterprise and Innovation, said; "This is a very significant day that puts Irish female entrepreneurship into the spotlight and celebrates the huge strides Irish businesswomen have made both here and internationally. Today is also an opportunity to inspire the female entrepreneurs of the future, by showing them what is possible and why they should be thinking global. Irish businesswomen have shown they can be the best in the world and we must continue in this frame of mind. The recent budget has shown my Department's commitment to business and entrepreneurs with a 22% increase in funding for the Local Enterprise Offices and we will continue to back our inspirational female entrepreneurs."

Marcella Rudden, Head of Enterprise, Local Enterprise Office Cavan said; "National Women's Enterprise Day is a key milestone for Local Enterprise Offices around the country. Since it started twelve years ago, the popularity of NWED has grown and every year we have more female success stories in business to highlight. The events are as important as ever, as they connect female entrepreneurs and give them the opportunity to learn from each other and share business challenges and solutions. For any female entrepreneurs in business or starting one up, our advice is to come and talk to the team at the Local Enterprise Office and we will quickly put vou on a path to the right enterprise supports.
