Cavan women learn the value of Peer to Peer knowledge Sharing

On April 3rd over 50 business women attended the CBWC to hear from Susan HayesCulleton, known as the Positive Economist, who gave a very energetic and uplifting presentation.

Also on the evening BECKSearch, a high tech on-line sharing of skills workshop was facilitated by Susan in a 'Peer to Peer Knowledge Sharing' session.

This enabled the business women in the room to flag what skills they need to help them in their business as well as offering advice in the areas they are expert on.

8 target skills were discussed on the Night:

- 1. Managing people effectively
- 2. Developing marketing techniques that show real returns
- 3. Resilience How to persevere when the going gets tough
- Identifying the "unique selling point" of me and/or my husiness
- 5. Getting to grips with the finances
- 6. Learning how to find and access the most valuable supports
- Networking strategically to find good customers/ suppliers and stakeholders
- 8. Understanding enough about tech to get things done

What came out of the BECKSearch online survey is that, as a group the CBWC members are a resilient bunch.

One skill that a large percentage of the members at the meeting wanted to learn more about is marketing.

We learned a number of points of interest on the night and these included:-

For **Resilience** or How to persevere when the going gets tough.

- Keep the wheel turning with another task
- Allow yourself have that bad day.
- Surround yourself with positive people

For **Developing Marketing Techniques** that show real returns

- Have a good website
- Actively use social media
- Above all else care for your customers

For **Networking Strategically** to find good customers/ suppliers and stakeholders


- Reputation is key and leads to referrals
