- The duration of the project work is **6 weeks** from **mid-June until the end of July**. (Students can be based on or off site.)
- Working in teams of 3 or 4, participants are **highly motivated and talented** with diverse personal and professional experience.
- Partner companies will receive a full written report including methodology, analysis and recommendations.
