2 Introduction

The inaugural SoCircular event took place on the 5th October, 2022 in the Round Room at the Mansion House, Dublin. It was led by Dublin City Council and LEO Dublin City in collaboration with Lord Mayor of Dublin, supported by various stakeholders and hosted in alignment with the EC ESER; UN SDG European Sustainable Development Week / Act4SDGs, Circular Week; National Social Enterprise Policy for Ireland; Dublin Regional Enterprise Plan; BuySocial IRL campaign and as a lead up event to Circular Economy Hotspot Dublin 2023.

The aim of SoCircular was to help transform Dublin by: celebrating the social and circular economy ecosystem, encouraging stakeholders to buy from and support local social and circular enterprises, promoting supports for enterprises to adopt circular / sustainability approaches, and through providing a forum for conversation on developing the social and circular economies in Dublin. In order to achieve this aim, SoCircular featured panel discussions on social and circular economy themes; fireside chats with key individuals including Minister Ossian Smyth, an immersive programme of social and circular themed arts and cultural performances and a trade expo comprised of 50 social and circular / sustainable enterprises along with support organisations.




