

Shopfront Improvement Scheme (Opens 28th March)

Kildare County Council has established the Shop Front Improvement, Accessibility and Age Friendly Grant Scheme to financially assist and support independent business owners to improve the appearance of their shop fronts or commercial properties. Particular emphasis should be on works to enhance accessibility and/or add age friendly elements to the premises.

This funding is being provided in recognition of the fact that a building's facade makes a big impact on our town centres. They help form people's first impressions of a town centre, so their condition can really affect a town's image. Smart shop fronts will make a town feel more prosperous, improve its image and contribute towards a stronger sense of identity.

Note: Applicants to our funding schemes will be automatically entered for our Pride of Place awards ceremony at the end of the year.

1. Who Can Apply?

Business owners/operators of independently owned shops fronting onto public streets are eligible to apply– see T&C's on https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/

2. What is it for?

Shopfront improvement works for something as simple as painting, lighting and signage to completely replacing your shopfront. It also supports age friendly and accessibility improvements to your shopfront.

3. When do I Apply?

The grant scheme is open for applications on submit.com from Monday 28th March. Visit https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/

The scheme will remain open until Tuesday 31st May or until the fund is exhausted, whichever occurs first.

4. What do I get?

A Grant up to a maximum of €5,000 or

- (i) Up to 50% of eligible costs (ex VAT) for painting / repairs (however, if you include an accessibility or age friendly element the grant offer can be increased up to 75% of eligible costs).
- (ii) Up to 75% of eligible costs (ex VAT) for accessibility improvements
- (iii) Up to 75% of eligible costs (ex VAT) for age friendly improvement

5. What do I need to do?

i. Fill the application form out on the link provided at https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/



- ii. Include a current photo of your shopfront premises
- iii. Provide written quotes for the work that is proposed
 - If application is for materials + labour up to and including a net value of €5,000: 2 quotations
 - If application is for materials + labour is over a net value of €5,000: 3 quotations
 Provide written proof of ownership (if the premises is owned) or written permission
 from the landlord/owner that the proposed work can be carried out.

6. How long have I to complete the works?

Works must be carried out within 4 months from the date on your letter of offer

7. How do I get paid?

You must submit your claim for payment within 30 days of the completion of works. Payment must be made to your contractor and all required claim documentation must be submitted before payment is approved.

Retail Window Merchandising Grant

Spring/Summer Call (Opens 5th May)

1. Who Can Apply?

All business owners/operators of independently owned shops are eligible to apply– see T&C's on https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/

2. What is it for?

The seasonal window display scheme is designed to enchance the visual streetscape of your town. This scheme will cover the cost of doing a seasonal window display for the Spring/Summer period.

3. When do I Apply?

The link for the grant scheme will be available at https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/ from Thursday 5th May. The scheme will close to applications on Friday 1st July. Please note you must attend the Visual Merchandising Workshop on Thursday 5th May to qualify for this scheme and monies will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

4. What do I get?

A Grant up to a maximum of €500 (ex VAT) or 80% of eligible expenditure

5. What do I need to do?

- i. Fill out the application form on the link provided on https://www.localenterprise.ie/Kildare/ Enterprise-Development/Shop-Front-Improvement-Scheme/
- ii. Include a current photo of your shopfront premises
- iii. Provide a written quote for the work that is proposed

6. How long have I to complete the works?

Works must be carried out within 3 months from the date on your letter of offer

7. How do I get paid?

You must submit your claim for payment within 30 days of the completion of works. All required claim documentation must be submitted before payment is approved.
