The competition is open to manufacturing & internationally traded services businesses in all sectors, structured at local or county level and culminates in a prestigious national final.

The aim of the National Enterprise Awards is to showcase, encourage and support a culture of enterprise and entrepreneurship in our communities in Ireland, to promote entrepreneurship and to showcase, encourage and to celebrate the achievement of clients of the LEOs.

The Brief

Local Enterprise Office Louth wishes to commission a Louth based artist or designer-maker to create a maximum 5 awards/trophies (4 sectoral awards plus one overall winner) to be presented to the winners at an event on March 7th

Materials to be considered will be ceramic, metal, wood, glass, stone, paper and/or textile, and the final works will need to be of a permanent nature (textiles will be expected to be durable for 5 years). The work should be designed with minimal ongoing maintenance requirements and should be domestic in scale.
