

Trading Online Voucher Seminar

With the trend ever increasing towards online spending it is estimated that only 23% of small Irish businesses are engaged in any meaningful way in e-commerce sales. For businesses employing less than ten people this percentage could be even lower. It is now believed that of online purchases made in Ireland that 70% of these are done in overseas markets. In order to help Irish businesses increase their online presence, vouchers up to a maximum value of €2,500 is available through the Mayo Local Enterprise Office. At the seminar will talk through eligibility for the scheme and discuss website development in general also.
