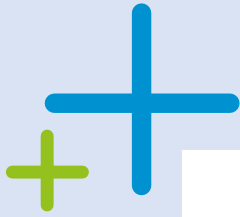

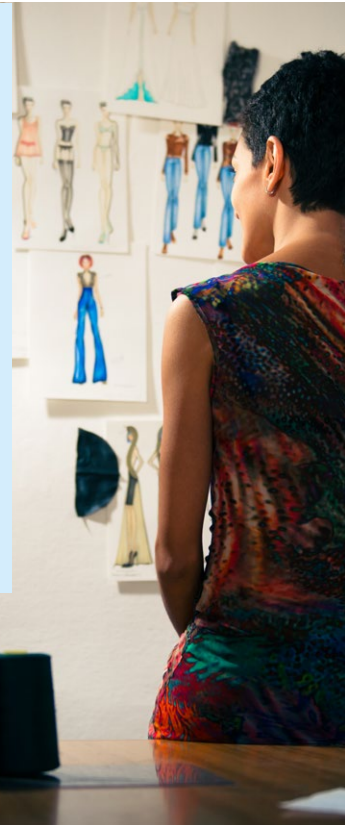
Registering your business
