# Two County Winners Reach 'Ireland's Best Young Entrepreneur' National Final

Two young Wicklow entrepreneurs won a place at the first-ever national final of 'Ireland's Best Young Entrepreneur' held in December 2014 having beaten off stiff competition at both County and Regional competitions.

Shane Byrne and Philip Kirwan from Show Off based in Wicklow town won the Regional Best Established Business Award. Show Off had already won their category and a €20,000 investment at the County Wicklow IBYE competition and in addition were crowned Wicklows Best Young Entrepreneur. Philip and Shane from Showoff, an App development company are developing a unique offering aimed at supporting independent living, health and well-being through the use of mobile and wearable technologies.

In the highly contested Start Up category, Michael Noble from Noble Education based in Enniskerry won the Regional Best Start up Award having already won the competition at County level including a €20,000 investment from the Local Enterprise Office in his internationally traded business, which develops mutually rewarding collaborations between European and South East Asian Higher Education Institutions.

Also a winner at County level was David Costello of Better Talk who won the Best New Idea Category with his business idea for a mobile based application which provides a platform that will change the way people discuss subjects online and allow businesses to more directly and effectively target their customers. The prize fund of €10,000 for the Best Idea will be used by David to bring his offering to market launch.

Ireland's Best Young Entrepreneur competition is an integral part of the Action Plan for Jobs 2014 and is supported by the Department of Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation through the 31 Local Enterprise Offices around the country.


